Dear parents and carers,

In my new role as Associate Assistant Headteacher I am taking over leadership of whole school rewards from Mrs Ainscough. As a starting point I wanted to give an overview of the whole school rewards that are currently in place and some tweaks that I will be making moving forward.

Pride of Cansfield (Yr7-9) / Blue Ties (Yr10) / Prefect Ties (Yr11) / Senior Prefect Ties (Yr11)

This is an area of the school rewards that we are very proud of and all the feedback we have received from students and parents indicates the reward works well. Criteria for the award involves attendance, punctuality, classroom conduct, behaviour and organisation. The award of this status is unashamedly reserved for those students who met the highest standards in the school. We will continue to operate in the same manner, with the latest badges and ties being awarded shortly after we return in the New Year.

Attendance Awards

The school gives out two attendance awards, which entitle students to wear a badge. A gold badge is awarded where students have achieved 100% attendance and a silver badge is awarded where students have achieved 97%. This is reviewed each half term with the next review planned for shortly after we return in the New Year.

0 Points Reward

At the end of every term there will be a reward, which only students who have not had any behaviour points that term will receive. The nature of the reward will be subject to variation. This term, it is an early Christmas Lunch with crackers.

Headteacher's Award

This was a new award that Mrs Ainscough introduced in October. I have reviewed feedback from students and parents and will be making it more exclusive with a more substantial reward. Moving forward the Headteacher's Award will be given to one student in every year group every half term. Each half term Heads of Year Academic and Heads of Year Pastoral will together nominate one individual from their year group who best demonstrates our values. Attaining this award will be a very significant achievement. Students will receive a personalised letter home explaining why they have received the award, along with a new badge that they will keep for the duration of their time at Cansfield High School. Also, all five winners will be taken out for a dinner with myself and Dr Baker to celebrate their new status.

Beyond this there are additional rewards at a Faculty and Year Group level that our students may be awarded while at Cansfield.
