Dear parents and carers,

Just a quick update regarding our strategy to mitigate the spread of COVID. While we have been able to control the spread within school through the mitigations that are currently in place, in light of rising infection rates nationally all schools in Wigan have received a recommendation from the Director of Public Health (Professor Kate Ardern) and the Assistant Director of Education (Cath Peeling) that face masks should be used in communal areas. We will be following this recommendation and from Monday will be asking students to wear face masks in corridors once again.

This only applies to communal areas and anything beyond that measure would require sign off from the Director of Public Health. As was the case previously, any students who cannot wear face masks will not be required to. We will be monitoring the situation closely and the Director of Public Health will let us know should there be any changes to this guidance moving forward.

Students have been fantastic with this in the past and we continue to be hugely grateful to parents, carers and students for your support and understanding during this period.
