### **Public Examination Notices**

In 2019, the Government introduced a 'contingency day' in the event of national or local disruption to examinations as part of the awarding bodies' standard contingency planning for examinations. This means that if disruption occurred the examinations will be moved to said contingency day instead of the published date. The year's contingency days are Thursday 8th June and Thursday 15th June 2023 (afternoons only), and Wednesday 28th June 2023 (all day).


All students have been provided with documentation covering the JCQ rules and regulations concerning the conduct within public examinations. The information regarding their examinations can be found in our website under the exams section. Additionally, all examination polices including: appeals process and procedures for late or absent students from examinations can be found within our polices section of the website.

Finally, students will continue with normal school days until their last examination. Students will conduct smart classes to prepare for imminent examinations with subject specialists during the school day. The only exceptions to this are as follows:

- Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> June, all students will conduct their Mathematics examination at 9:00am and will be expected to stay in school until 1:00pm to revise for their Science examination.
- Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> June, all students will be in school from 8:30am – 1:00pm to revise for their final Science examination on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June.
- Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> June, students who study Geography will be in school from 8:30am – 3:15pm to revise for their final Geography examination on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June.
- Students conducting the Hospitality and Catering examination on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> June will be expected to come into school on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> June from 8:30am to 12:00pm.

We will conduct a leavers assembly with Year 11 students on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June at 9:00am. Students must attend in full school uniform entering via the gym fire doors where they will be registered.
