Dear Parent/Guardian,

Now that the end of term is upon us you may be thinking about purchasing new uniform ready for September. Please see our website for the full list of uniform expectations. We have, as you know, made changes to the PE Kit to limit the options and reduce the cost of the overall purchase.

I would like to draw to your attention the following: -

- School skirts should be black and just above the knee with the school lion showing (you can however purchase plain black skirts). Students will be asked to roll down or replace any skirt staff deem too short.
- School trousers should be black and a traditional style, not fitted, skinny, flared, leggings or jean type.
- Socks should be black
- Shoes should be black, polishable, formal and with a low heel and no visible gems, bows or gold chains. For example, Nike Air Force and Vivienne Westwood shoes are not allowed (there is a picture attached of appropriate shoes). Those that resemble training shoes or boots are not acceptable.
- Jumpers are optional, but blazers are not. They must be worn in school.
- Hair by the time we return in September is to be a natural colour and nothing less than a number 2 and an appropriate style. No unnatural colouring or hairstyles, for example a blocked-out fringe. Only blue bows are allowed.
- Students choosing to have a piercing should have this done early in the summer to give enough time for healing. Any pupils with nose studs or earrings will be asked to take these out and placed in a plastic wallet for collection at the end of the day. No other forms of jewellery are allowed with the exception of a watch.

May I take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support in ensuring our uniform is of the highest standard. If you have any queries or need any support with this at all, please contact me at school.
