Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope this message finds you well. I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support in helping prepare our Year 11 students for their GCSE exams. Your encouragement, guidance, and involvement at home play a vital role in their success, and we truly appreciate the strong partnership between home and school during this important time.

We are incredibly proud of our Year 11 students. Their attitude and engagement in their exams so far have been fantastic, and they have approached this period with maturity, determination and focus. Their resilience, commitment and positive approach have been truly commendable, and they have represented themselves exceptionally well. As we move into the final weeks of examinations, I would like to outline the arrangements in place. Students will continue to attend school as normal up until Tuesday 9th June, during which time they will take part in targeted revision sessions with subject specialists. From Tuesday 9th June onwards, please take note of the following specific arrangements:

- **Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> June:** Pupils will have targeted Maths & Science revision during the morning. All year 11 pupils to stay in school until 1.20pm.
- **Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> June:** Maths exam at 9:00am. All students stay until 1:20pm for Science and/or Geography revision.
- **Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June:** Geography Exam at 9:00am. All students stay until 10:55am for Science revision. Geography and Hospitality & Catering students to stay in school till 12.15pm. Geography students will attend Science revision and Hospitality & Catering will prepare for their exam on Friday.
- **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June:** Chemistry exam at 9:00am. Pupils to stay in school until 10:55 to complete Physics revision. Hospitality & Catering and Polish students will remain in school to complete revision before their exam in the afternoon.
- **Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June:** Physics exam will take place at 9:00am. Students will remain in school afterwards for their Leavers' Assembly at 11:30am. Prior to the assembly, there will be an opportunity for students to have their school shirts signed. Students will then leave school at the conclusion of the assembly.
