We know many of you are eagerly anticipating results day. You'll be able to collect your results on Thursday 20th August at 9.00am, entering school via the Cansfield Grove entrance.

If you're unable to collect your results in person, please ensure that a signed letter of consent is provided, naming the adult who will be collecting on your behalf. That adult must bring the letter with them on the day.

On results day, you will be asked to complete an **Access to Scripts form**. This gives you the option to allow the school to request your exam scripts. You can choose for all, some, or none of your scripts to be accessed.

We may request your scripts for two reasons:

- to support teaching and learning (you can choose whether your name is shown or removed),
- to help decide if it is worth requesting a review of marking, for example if your mark is close to a grade boundary.

You must complete the form clearly and include your email address and mobile number. If we think a review of marking may be appropriate, we will email you with details, deadlines and ask for your permission. A Head of Subject will also contact you to discuss this before you decide. We cannot proceed without your written consent, and you will be informed of the outcome once it has been received.

Support and guidance will be available on site for anyone who needs advice on their next steps.
